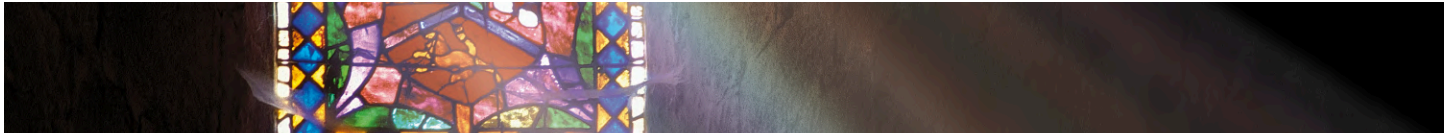

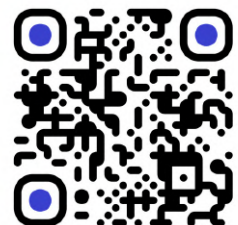

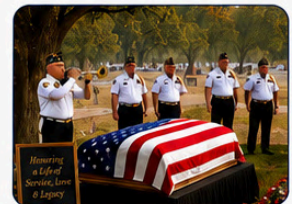

Youth

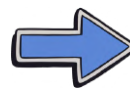

Sea Cadets

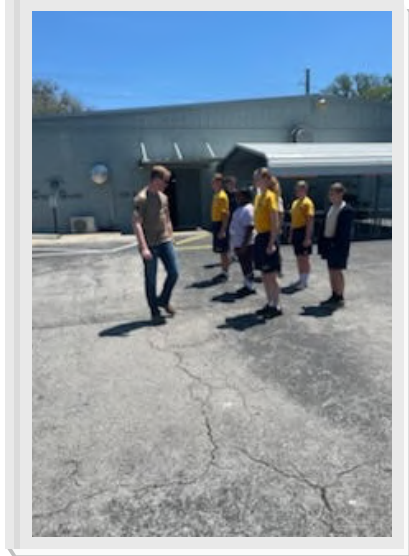
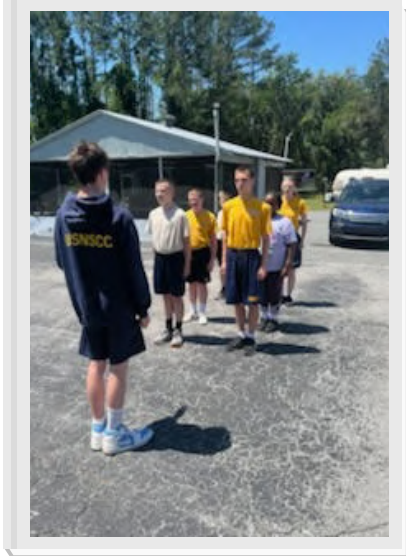

We break for the summer, and cadets go to summer trainings. We start back up with unit drills in August.

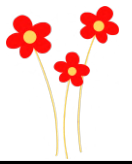
