She has been highlighting opportunities available to our members and looking for new opportunities to be of service. She appreciates any and all suggestions. If there is something you enjoy doing, making or teaching Weegie is the one who can turn it into a volunteer opportunity to serve our veterans and the community!

As a reminder, our new colors for the year are kaki, navy blue, army green, camouflage, and black. This coincides with the motto this year of Mission Auxiliary; Serving Heroes, Success is the only option. This doesn't take the place of Red Shirt Friday, and it is still exciting to see all of the red at the Post on Fridays.

On August 26th we attended the monthly Afternoon Tea for the ladies at the Domiciliary. As always, they really enjoyed the time with us as we enjoyed our time with them. The treats were great as usual, and they like the opportunity to get dressed up a little with hats and other accessories. In September they will be doing Glamour Shots.

Ongoing projects and opportunities to be involved:

Quilts of Valor is an ongoing project, and we host 1- 2 classes monthly teaching basic sewing skills in order to make the quilt tops. Bringing your own portable sewing machine would be helpful.

On September 19 th we will have our annual indoor yard sale. Time to clean out cupboards, closets, the garage and any other place in your home that needs purging. We will take anything that is not objectional. We can take furniture and other big items along with clothing and household goods. We cannot collect any items until the week of the sale; however, you can bring things to the General Meeting in September and through that week. Large items, such as furniture pieces, can only come into the hall on Friday before the sale day. On Friday, September 18 th at 3:00 we are planning to meet in the hall to organize and display our wares.

These go to homeless teens and adult women through various organizations and to school nurses in Columbia County schools for distribution as needed. We will be gearing up soon to begin candy collections for our fall activities. We are not collecting school supplies this year as we discovered that giving a money donation from the Auxiliary goes much farther than these individual donations.

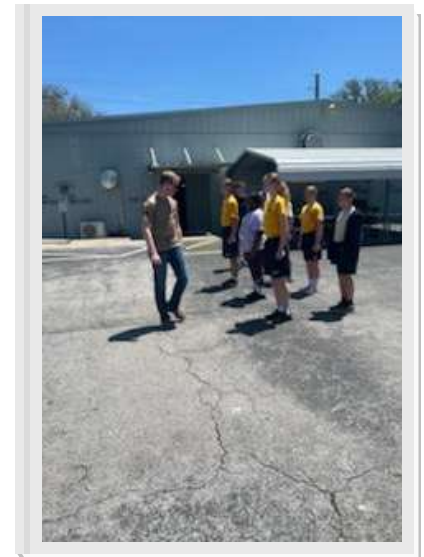
Sea Cadets
